FINANCIAL RESOURCES

Our organisation has a dual financing system.

We are mainly financed by membership fees. Our members pay a minimum annual contribution
 (48 Euro/ 24 Euro semester)
 for the processing of your application or the required documents.



FINANCIAL RESOURCES

We can apply for public funding each year to finance part of the personnel and maintenance costs from public funds.

AGEyR receives public support every year (JUNTA DE ANDALUCIA, DIPUTACIÓN DE GRANADA, etc.).

However, it is not always the same amount and the same subsidies or support are not possible every year.
