## Specialist counselling



- Counselling topics: Emigration, return to Germany, binational couples, onward migration and return of refugees
- Individual case research for specific and country-related information
- Contacts to experts, e.g. foreign representations, legal advisors on residence law, social insurance



#### Examples of topics dealt with



- Immigration and residence regulations
- Social security
- Recognition of professional and educational qualifications
- Taxes and import regulations
- Family law and international matrimonial and child custody law
- Practical questions: e.g. driving licence, schools, cost of living



## From the consultation: Return from Austria, binational



German with third-country national husband; have lived in Austria for 4 years; he has a residence card in Austria; both have job offers in Germany/NRW

**Challenge:** Right of residence, visa procedure? People seeking advice have received unclear information from other agencies, as the constellation is rare; procedure drags on

**Solution:** Return case according to the Freedom of Movement Act: No visa to enter the country, immediate access to the labour market, no proof of German language skills

## Further training



Organisation of further training and professional exchange meetings:

- Country topics: Living and working in ...
- Specialist topics e.g. health insurance, mobile working, return to Germany (right of residence for non-German family members, access to social benefits)
- Exchange with other organisations, e.g. airport social services, German Welfare Council in London

#### **EURES** network



- Network for the promotion of professional mobility between the EU, EEA and Switzerland
- Members: public employment services and organisations that promote freedom of movement
- Services for people wishing to work in another EU country and for companies wishing to recruit European specialists.
- The issue of the return of nationals is also increasingly being focussed on.
